Dubrovnik – Split – Hvar – Plitvice Lakes National Park – Lake Balaton – Budapest

1st day Arrival in Dubrovnik

10-day tour

2nd day City tour in Dubrovnik

The 'Pearl of the Adriatic', situated on the Dalmatian coast, is a remarkably well-preserved example of a late-medieval walled city. Although severely damaged by an earthquake and in armed conflicts, Dubrovnik managed to preserve its beautiful Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque churches, monasteries, palaces and fountains.

3rd day Transfer to Split

Split is probably the most Mediterranean, dynamic and youthful city of Croatia. But the heart of Dalmatia is also famous for its 1700 year old cultural and architectural heritage.

4th day Boat trip to the island of Hvar

The island of Hvar is not only famous for its charming bays, beaches and vibrant nightlife but it has beautiful examples of Venetian architecture and a UNESCO world heritage site, the Stari Grad Plain, a cultural landscape that has remained practically intact since it was first colonized by the Greeks in the 4th century BC.

5th day Transfer to Plitvice Lakes National Park

Plitvice Lakes National Park contains a series of beautiful lakes, caves and waterfalls. These have been formed by processes typical of karst landscapes. These geological processes continue today. The forests in the park are home to bears, wolves and many rare bird species.





6th day Lake Balaton

We dedicate the whole day to the northern uplands of the Lake Balaton which is undoubtedly the most beautiful wine region of Hungary. In the evening jeep-tour with winetasting.

7th day Transfer to Budapest

On our way to Budapest we stop by Tihany, a charming village with an almost millennial benedictine abbey and an exceptional view of the Lake Balaton.

8th day City tour in Budapest

Budapest has one of the world's most outstanding urban landscapes which illustrates the great periods in the history of Hungary.

9th day Day trip to the Danube Bend

The Danube Bend is a beautiful region located close to Budapest, rich in cultural and natural treasures.

10th day Departure
